Damodar Valley Corporation, the first major multi-purpose integrated River Valley Project of the country conceived in line of Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA) came into existence on July 7, 1948, by an Act of Central Legislature. The mission at the time of its inception was flood control, irrigation, water supply, navigation and drainage, generation, transmission & distribution of Electricity, afforestation etc.

SELECTION PROCESS:

Candidates found apparently eligible will have to undergo a written/selection test which will be followed by personal interview of short listed candidates. Based on merit and requirement, the list of successful candidates for interview will be made available at <http://www.dvc.gov.in>.

Mere appearing in the written test and even in interview does not ensure eligibility of a candidate for the particular post applied for. Selection is subject to the fulfillment of all the criteria during entire process of recruitment.

1.1.2009 :

General Category is 29 years as on 01.01.2009 i.e 01.01.1980 need not apply.

1. The upper age limit for OBC (Non-creamy layer) is 32 years as on 01.01.2009 i.e candidate born before 01.01.1977 need not apply.
2. The upper age limit for SC/ST Category is 34 years as on 01.01.2009 i.e candidate born before 01.01.1975 need not apply.
3. For PH Candidate, the Upper age limit is as per the GOI Rule.

EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATION:

4 years full time Bachelor Degree in Engineering & Technology in respective subject(as mentioned below) from any recognized College/Institute/University, approved by AICTE with not less than 65% marks in aggregate for General and OBC candidates. 5% marks is relaxable for SC & ST candidates:

Final year appearing candidates with 65 % (for GEN & OBC) / 60% (for SC/ST) marks in aggregate in the 6(six) completed semesters / 3(three) years examination and expecting final semester result by August'2009 are also eligible to apply for the above posts.

RESERVATIONS AND RELAXATIONS:

1. Reservations and relaxations for SC / ST / OBC (non-creamy layer) / Physically Handicapped (degree of disability 40% or above) candidates will be provided as per GOI Directives.
2. Category (SC / ST / OBC/ PH) once filled in the online application form will not be changed and no benefit of other category will be admissible later on.
3. No registration fee will be charged from SC/ST/Physically Challenged categories and departmental candidates.
4. The upper age limit is relaxable by 5 years for SC/ST, 3 years for OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) candidates. For PH candidates, it is relaxable by 10 years for PH-General, 13 years for PH-OBC and 15 years for PH-SC/ST candidates.
5. The OBC candidates who belong to "Creamy Layer" are not entitled for OBC concession and such candidates have to indicate their category not as OBC but as General only.
6. Necessary caste / tribe / OBC (non-creamy layer)/ Disability certificate in the prescribed form issued by the competent authority specified by GOI Rules/Orders must be furnished for claiming such relaxation.

SERVICE AGREEMENT BOND:

All the candidates selected for appointment shall be required to execute a service agreement bond of Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees two lakh) for serving at least 4 years in DVC. This should be submitted at the time of joining as per DVC format.

COMPENSATION PACKAGE:

Selected candidates will be placed in the pay scale of Rs. 15,600-39,100/- + Grade Pay (PB3) Rs.5,650/- during One-year training period. After successful completion of one year training period, he/she will be absorbed as Assistant Engineer in the above pay scale with one increment in the above pay scale. Besides basic pay, candidates will also be paid Central Dearness Allowance. Other Allowances and benefits such as leave, medical treatment, Leave Travel Allowance, Provident Fund, Gratuity, Conveyance Allowance, and HRA etc admissible as per company's rules in force from time to time during training / after absorption.

PLACEMENT:

The selected candidates shall undergo one year training at various DVC formations. After successful completion of one year training to the best satisfaction of the Corporation, they will be absorbed as Asstt. Engineer at any of the projects/ stations or offices of DVC.

TEST CENTERS:

The selection test will be held in Kolkata and Ranchi as mentioned in the online application system. Candidates have to choose one of the centers as Test Center and no change in any circumstance will be considered subsequently.

Admission to the test center will be on production of Admit Card, which is to be downloaded by the candidates only from the website.

ABOUT TEST:

The selection test is tentatively scheduled on 2.8.2009 (Sunday). The test will be of 2(two) hours duration consisting of 80 multiple-choice questions of the relevant technical disciplines and 40 multiple-choice questions on Aptitude/GK/Current Affairs. Each question will carry 1 equal mark. 1/4th mark will be deducted for each wrong answer.

HOW TO APPLY:

Candidates will have to apply online through DVC's website www.dvc.gov.in. Each candidate should have a valid E-mail ID atleast for subsequent 6(six) months. General as well as OBC category candidates are required to pay a non-refundable Demand Draft of Rs.300/- as registration fee drawn in favour of **"The Chief Accounts Officer, DVC, Kolkata"** payable at Kolkata.

No application fee is needed for SC/ST/PH and departmental candidates. SC/ST/PH category candidate has to submit attested copy of the relevant Certificate(s) as mentioned hereunder.

No other mode of payment would be accepted. Candidates can visit the online registration site from 04.06.2009 till 24-00 hrs.(midnight) of 23.06.2009.

After applying online, candidate is required to download the registration slip generated by the system in duplicate with unique registration number. Please paste one colored passport photograph (3.5 cm x 3.5 cm) **not older than 3 months** at the required place and sign on the registration slip. The candidate has to send one print out of the 'Registration Slip' duly completed along with **5(five) nos. photographs, each identical to the one pasted on the Regn. slip** and Demand Draft of Rs 300.00 (For GEN and OBC candidates only). **The Reserved category candidates must enclose Caste or Tribe Certificate, age proof certificate and /or Disability certificate, as applicable, along with the registration slip. The registration number, name, discipline and category should be written at the back of the Demand Draft.**

The envelope should be superscribed as i) GET - (MECHANICAL/ ELECTRICAL/ Control & Instrumentation) ii) GEN/ OBC/ SC/ ST/ PH and iii) Registration number with a tick mark on corresponding selection and striking off the others.
